The start of the year is a time to remind our community of the processes at KPS for everyone in our community. So here are a few reminders:

Hats-SunSmart School

School Yard Supervision

Soft Start

Commences at 8:50am for all neighbourhoods.

Parking

Please be reminded that we have 2 school entries, the front gate and Ventura Way. Please do not double park to drop children off, if you are dropping off and you are not getting out you must pull up to the curb. Safety is the biggest concern for our community. Be aware that we have 70 more children attending school this year so parking will get busier. Parking around the reserve across the road is also a good option as Natalie our crossing supervisor is present to support our children as they cross Blossom Drive.

Nude Food School

We ask that families send minimal wrappings etc on snacks and lunch. Wrappers and packaging will be sent home in lunch boxes.





