Dear Families,

Welcome to the final week of 2023. We have had another productive year with many exciting and new activities and learning put into place for our learners. There have been many highlights in a year that has seen all schools struggle with recruitment and class coverage with a very low number of available CRTs (relief teachers). Our children have managed well when these challenges have been thrown in their direction and overall, this has developed resilience in our children.

KPS Fly High night, swimming, orienteering, school athletics carnival, school cross country, Prep breakfast, 2 school camps, 1 sleep over and a disco night and the whole school family Picnic.

Family events included many exhibitions across each area of the school. Science night, Footy Day and Art Show and the huge highlight the Dance Showcase, Parent and Special Person stalls.

Excursions to the Zoo, Werribee and the city, Puffing Billy, local walks, GRIP Leadership and Life Education van visit. Incursions including Wild Action Animals for Prep and Year 1, visits from the fire brigade, ambulance, police, and responsible pet ownership. The Dental van also visited over 5 days in the year.
