Art Through Time

Students will explore the theme of art history which will include looking at Cave Art from around the world, Medieval art, Botanical Art, Art Nouveau, Machines and Bauhaus. Together we will build an understanding of how art can teach us about the past.

Foundation, Year One & Two will combine drawing, craft, collage, stencils and sculpture to create artworks inspired by the above themes. There will be an emphasis on collaboration and building confidence with crafting materials. Keep an eye out for a stained-glass window transformation inspired by Gothic architecture!

Year Three and Four will investigate historical artworks from different times and cultures around the world. Students will continue to develop their drawing skills by observing and drawing objects from nature just like the explorers.

Years Five and Six will create artworks inspired by Canopic jars which were used by the ancient Egyptians during the mummification process. They will create their own animal based symmetrical artwork in Art Nouveau style. Students will continue to improve their observational drawing skills and collaborate to install their artworks.
