# **ICAS INFORMATION - 2024**



## What is ICAS?

ICAS is an online academic competition, open to students in Year 2 to Year 6, that is designed to assess students' higher order thinking and problem-solving skills in English, Mathematics, Science, Writing, Spelling Bee and Digital Technologies.

- Each assessment celebrates students' accomplishments by providing opportunities for recognition and development.
- Every student who participates will receive a printed certificate and an online results report.
- Top performers will be eligible for medals.

## How do I register my child?

If you wish for your child to participate in ICAS this year, please:

- 1. Go to Parent Portal here: (https://shop.icasassessments.com/pages/pps)
- 2. Enter our school's access code SOE308
- 3. Enter your child's details
- 4. Select the tests you would like to purchase, then proceed to payment.

After payment is made via the Parent Payment System, you will receive an order confirmation email, <u>please keep this for your records.</u>

## The final date to sign your child up for ICAS is Monday 29th July.

## What will we do?

We will notify you of the date(s) that we run ICAS at Keelonith and when your child's ICAS results are ready. You and your child can access the results once released via the Reports Portal using the TAP ID and pin found on the back of the ICAS certificate.

We are proud to offer ICAS and look forward to some fantastic results later in the year.



Technology Buzz with Dion and Lucas 3/4



It is important that we protect our computers and devices by creating very strong passwords.

Some important things to consider when creating your password:

- 1. Create a Super-Secret Code: Make a special code that only you know and make it longer for.
- 2. Change It Up: Sometimes, change your code to keep it super safe!
- 3. Extra Protection: Use a special helper, like a code sent to your phone, for more safety and never download anything suspicious.
- 4. Locked Out: If someone tries to guess your code too many times, your stuff stays safe by locking them out.
- 5. Keep It Safe: Keep your code safe like a treasure, and only share it with a grown up or classroom teacher. Don't share it with your friends!
- 6. Learn More: Talk to your grown-up or teacher to learn more about making strong codes to keep your stuff safe!


