WHAT ARE WE LEARNING?

Literature Focus: The Arrival by Shaun Tan - Our first literature focus will explore themes of family, struggle, and hope. We will analyse pictures to understand their meaning, interpret characters' emotions, and uncover symbolism.

Biological Science: Habitats - Students will discover how living things survive and grow. We will learn how temperature affects fungi, what plants need to thrive, and how some creatures live in extreme places like deserts, deep oceans, and freezing Antarctica.

Biological Science: Plant Survival - Students will explore how plants survive and thrive. We will learn about their special traits, smart adaptations, and how they handle heat, cold, and tough environments to stay strong and grow.

Literature Focus: Tom Appleby by Jackie French - Our second literature focus will step into the world of early Australia and the struggles of convicts, discover their harsh conditions, lost freedoms, and the power of friendship. See how they adapted to survive, helped build a new colony, and faced questions of justice and punishment in a challenging new land.

In Week 6, the whole school will explore and celebrate Reconciliation Week.
