Storm Boy

We will read the classic Australian Text, 'Storm Boy' and learn about how the language in texts create images that help us understand what we are reading. We will take notes and engage in discussion to deepen our understanding of the story.

Science

Our focus will be on exploring the observable features of living things and how these features help us to group them, and distinguish them from non-living things. We will investigate life cycles and how living things depend on each other to survive.

Reconciliation Week

Students will explore Reconciliation Week to reflect on the connection between the past, present and future of Indigenous Australians. We will investigate different points of view and consider what connects us with Indigenous Australians to achieve reconciliation.

Finding Our Heart

We will read the text 'Finding Our Heart' to understand the connection between Indigenous Australians and the land. We will learn that their voices are an important part of working together to take care of Australia and how we can move forward to connect with each other.
