

YEAR 3 TERM 2 OVERVIEW

LITERATURE

During Term 2, Students will begin with a literature focus. We will be exploring the text 'Charlotte's Web' by E.B White. Students will be looking at key themes such as friendship and loyalty. We're focusing on character development, understanding how the personalities and actions of Wilbur, Charlotte, and other characters help shape the story. Students are also learning to identify rich vocabulary and will explore the author's use of descriptive language to bring the farm setting and its characters to life.

BIOLOGICAL SCIENCE

This term in Science, our Year 3 students are exploring the fascinating world of living things! We're learning about the biological features of animals and plants and how these help them survive in their environments. Students are also discovering the life cycles of different animals and plants, gaining an understanding of how living things grow, change and reproduce.

LITERATURE

Towards the end of the term, students will explore the text 'The Stone Lion', by Margaret Wild. Students will examine the illustrations and explore how they help bring the story to life and add meaning to the text.
