Literature Focus


Through rich literature experiences, students will respond to the book *Little Turtle and the Sea*, by Becky Davies. They will identify many features of the text, the writers use of adjectives, audience and purpose, and answer questions about the text. They will develop comprehension skills and express ideas through discussions and writing.

Science – Living Things

Students will be exploring living things, their features and their habitats. Students will learn about different habitats and how they provide what living things need to survive. They will explore identifiable features of animals and how they adapt to their environment, including the lifecycle of different animals.
