What is in the Sky?

This term, students will learn about the Earth and the other planets of the solar system. We will explore their movement and patterns. We will investigate daily and seasonal changes in the weather and environment, and how they affect our daily decisions.

Reconciliation Week

Students will learn about what Reconciliation Week is. They will learn that Aboriginal Australians lived in Australia for thousands of years.

Literature Focus



The literature focus this term will be on the text Edward the Emu. Students will focus on comprehension strategies, understanding character actions and character development. They will also use a story map to plot key events.
