What are we learning?

Reversible & Irreversible change

Students will learn that some changes caused by chemical reactions cannot be reversed, that chemical reactions can be identified and grouped into different types, and that heat energy can cause irreversible changes. They will show their understanding by comparing reversible and irreversible changes.

Literature Focus: 'Once' by Morris Gleitzman

Students will learn how to analyse characters in a text, answer questions using information they hear in an audio text, and identify important social, personal, and moral messages within a text.

Body Systems & Health

Students will learn how family, friends, media, and influencers can affect their health choices. They will understand who to talk to when they have health questions or concerns and learn how to check whether health information is trustworthy. They will show their learning by identifying influences on health decisions, communicating with trusted adults, and recognising reliable health information.

Reminders

- **Home Reading** - 20 minutes, 4 times per week. Please sign your child's student diary and bring it to school each Monday.
