What we are learning this term:

Science – Solids, Liquids and Gases

To kick-start our term, students will be learning about the different states of matter and exploring how heating and cooling materials can change their state.

Literacy – Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo

Students will follow Michael as he learns to survive on his own after being washed up on a deserted island. Students will practice summarising the text to support them in remembering important information.

Humanities – Local Government

To finish the term, students will take a deep dive into local government and explore what local governments do and how their decisions are made.
